3. Hazards identification

Highly flammable. Irritating to eyes. Repeated exposure may cause skin dryness or cracking. Vapors may cause drowsiness and dizziness.

4. First aid measures

- After inhalation: Provide with fresh air
- After skin contact: Take off all contaminated clothing, wash with plenty of water
- After eye contact: Rinse thoroughly with plenty of water and seek medical advice
- After swallowing: Immediately drink plenty of water; Seek medical advice and show this container or label

5. Fire-fighting measures

- **Suitable extinguishing media:**
Carbon Dioxide (CO₂), powder
- **Special protective equipment for fire fighting:**
Do not stay in danger zone without self-contained breathing apparatus.
- **Other information:**
Cool container with water spray from a safe distance. Contain escaping vapors with water. Prevent fire-fighting water from entering surface water or groundwater. Keep away from sources of ignition.
- **Special risks:**
Highly Flammable. Vapors heavier than air. Forms explosive mixtures with air at



ambient temperatures. Development of hazardous combustion gases or vapors possible in the event of fire.

6. Accidental release measures

- **Person-related precautionary measures:**
Do not inhale vapors/aerosols. Ensure supply of fresh air in enclosed rooms.
- **Environmental-protection measures:**
Do not allow to enter sewage system.
- **Procedures for cleaning / absorption:**
Take up with liquid-absorbent material. Forward for disposal. Clean affected area.

7. Handling and storage

- **Handling:**
Take precautionary measures against static discharges. Keep away from source of ignition. When using do not eat or drink.
- **Storage:**
Tightly closed, in a well-ventilated place. Keep away from source of ignition - no smoking.

8. Exposure controls and personal protection

- **Exposure limits**
Avoid contact with eyes, skin, clothing, and breathing vapor.
- **Personal protective equipment:**
Protective clothing should be selected specifically for the working place, depending on concentration and quantity of the hazardous substances handled. The resistance of the protective clothing to chemicals should be ascertained with the respective supplier.
 - Respiratory protection: Required when vapors/aerosols are generated.
 - Eye protection: Wear eye/ face protection
 - Hand protection: Wear suitable gloves
 - Industrial hygiene: Change contaminated clothing. Application of skin-protective barrier cream recommended. Wash hands after working with substance.
